<u>Sample Daily Itinerary:</u>

Regular camp hours run 9AM-3PM with the options of adding on early drop-off or latepickup (or both!) to extend the total camp hours to 8:30AM-4PM.

Full week registrations will be active January - February and single day registrations will then open February - June.

Spaces are extremely limited each week so be sure to reserve your spot as soon as possible!
