Entire Building	\$1,000,000	Center for Wildlife's dream building, serving wildlife and the community
Medical Clinic Wing <i>(Anonymous York Resident)</i>	\$250,000	The entire medical clinic, including ICU, exams, x-ray, and nurseries
Education and Outreach Wing	\$250,000	Nature center and auditorium
Intern Housing	\$150,000	Dormitory for interns and apprentices from across the country
X-Ray and Surgical Suite <i>(In Memory of Barbara Wilson Gomez)</i>	\$100,000	X-ray, pharmacy, diagnostics, examination and surgery
Teaching and Training Classroom	\$100,000	Ground floor conference room and classroom
Learning Auditorium <i>(In Memory of Joseph and Viola Benz by their Daughter, Charity)</i>	\$100,000	Seating for 120 people to be used for large group presentations, earned income events, conferences and workshops, training, and local non-profit use
Welcome Atrium <i>(Larrea Family Foundation)</i>	\$100,000	Animal admission drop-off, visitor check-in, guided and self-guided tours

Pollinator and Organic Food Gardens	\$75,000	Native plant species for pollinators, as well as organic foods like lettuce and blueberries for our patients and ambassadors
Mindfulness Pavilion	\$75,000	A place for people to quietly connect with nature and their surroundings
Nature Discovery Center	\$75,000	Interactive and hands-on learning center for visitors, queue for large groups, and waiting area for admissions drop-off's
Intensive Care Recovery <i>(Suzanne and Albert Frederick)</i>	\$75,000	Recovery room for animals with severe trauma, including fractures, eye and head trauma, or open wounds
Outdoor Amphitheater <i>(Coastal Landscaping)</i>	\$50,000	Tiered outdoor seating for public programs and events, guest lecturers, and large outdoor presentations
Quiet Recovery	\$50,000	Quite space for high stress patients like Eastern cottontails and bats
Songbird Nursery <i>(In Memory of Richard A. Cabral)</i>	\$50,000	Recovery for over 100 species of local songbirds
Baby Mammal Nursery <i>(Penates Foundation)</i>	\$50,000	Recovery for orphaned baby mammals, like squirrels, opossums, chipmunks, and porcupines
Aquatic Species Recovery <i>(In Memory of Leon Peter John Stawasz)</i>	\$50,000	Wet room for turtles, seabirds, and freshwater bird patient swimming, waterproofing, and recovery
Outdoor Education Ambassadors Display <i>(Kenneth and Charley Levine)</i>	\$50,000	Visiting area and sanctuary for our 25 non-releasable hawks, owls, falcons, opossum, turtles, porcupine, and gray squirrel ambassadors

Raptor Recovery Enclosures <i>(TABB Family Trust)</i>	\$50,000	Outdoor enclosures and healing space for raptor patients
Mammal Recovery Enclosures <i>(Shalin Liu Mammal Recovery Enclosures)</i>	\$50,000	Outdoor enclosures and healing space for mammal patients
Native Landscaping	\$50,000	Native shrub, fern, and tree plantings for an ecologically sensitive campus
Emergency Hotline and Admissions	\$50,000	Front Desk and Wildlife Assistance Hotline- first line of defense in preventing injury and impact to native wildlife
Solar Panels <i>(Maine Beer Company)</i>	\$25,000	Solar for the entire building, fueling life-saving equipment and lighting with the sun
Nature Trails <i>(Quimby Family Foundation)</i>	\$25,000	Nature trail for visitors, tours, and education programs
Vernal Pool Boardwalk <i>(In memory of Monty Griffin)</i>	\$25,000	Vernal pool trail for species exploration and education programs
Native Landscaping <i>(The Patten Family)</i>	\$25,000	Low maintenance, wildlife and pollinator friendly landscaping for nature trails and visitor areas
Outdoor Signage	\$25,000	Visitor signage, and outdoor interactive displays and kiosks.

Quiet Recovery Room <i>(Anonymous)</i>	\$25,000	Isolation for high stress and endangered species like New England cottontail, bats, etc.
Learning Lab <i>(Cheryl Richardson)</i>	\$25,000	Indoor learning and practice facilities for interns and volunteers to practice advanced medical skills
Conference Room <i>(Reed Conference Room)</i>	\$25,000	A learning space to host onsite meetings, conferences, and workshops for community members and partners
Exam Room <i>(Named in honor of John Means, DVM)</i>	\$25,000	Where initial examinations are performed in the medical clinic. All animals will pass through this space.
Reference Library <i>(Named in memory of William C. Stasulis)</i>	\$25,000	Library and reference collection for interns, volunteers, and staff to utilize. Will also be available for onsite guests.
Rainwater Gardens	\$25,000	Rainwater collection system to mitigate runoff from impervious surfaces to local ecosystem
Barred Owl Hollow <i>(Named in memory of Priscilla Perry Forte)</i>	\$25,000	Boardwalk and signage near barred owls and vernal pool area
Reflection Pool <i>(Named in memory of Kip Knox)</i>	\$25,000	Quiet reflection area and water feature
Nature Center Tree	\$25,000	Focal point of Nature Discovery Center. Visitors will learn native species and resource partitioning with this hands-on display
Children's Play Area	\$25,000	Natural logs, boulders, and tree rounds to promote free play

Turtle Safe Zone	\$25,000	Culverts, seasonal speed bumps, and signage to create a turtle safe campus
Bird Safe Glass	\$20,000 <i>(or 2 @ \$10,000 each)</i>	Window treatments to prevent birds from flying into glass during migrating and breeding seasons. Small display will inspire others
Dark Skies Lighting	\$20,000 <i>(or 4 lamp posts @ \$5,000 each)</i>	Specialized lighting and design to support dark skies initiative (preventing impact to local wildlife breeding and lifespan)
Nocturnal Animals and Bats Exhibit <i>(Maine Beer Company)</i>	\$15,000	Indoor bats, flying squirrels, and other small nocturnal mammals exhibit
Medical Clinic Viewing Deck	\$15,000	One way window to view wildlife rehabilitation in action!
Vernal Pool Exhibit <i>(1) Ambit Engineering</i> <i>(1) Kittery Trading Post</i>	\$15,000 <i>(or 3 @ \$5,000)</i>	Touch tank, signage, and sound will make unique vernal pools and their relevance to upland forest come alive
Community Art Wall <i>(Shapiro Family)</i>	\$10,000	Artists in residence will form a gallery to display local art on a rotating basis
Benches/Seating Areas <i>(1) in honor of Meg Rotondo</i> <i>(1) in honor of Anne Martin</i> <i>(1) in memory of Mary Ruth Baughman Doye</i>	\$10,000 each <i>(6 Available)</i>	Seating and benches around facility
Joe's Bird Blind <i>(Anonymous)</i>	\$10,000	Photography blind with feeding station in honor of volunteer Joe Mazzaglia

Forest Mud Kitchen <i>(Robin Mahoney)</i>	\$10,000	Outdoor play kitchen for kids to create pretend food platters and learn natural history
Bianca's Nest <i>(Rhonda and Sharon Bovio)</i>	\$10,000	Life-sized outdoor nest for friend and family photo opportunities. Named in honor of CFW barred owl matriarch, Bianca
Budding Scientist Area	\$10,000	Indoor exploration including microscopes, pellet dissection, and bone identification
Spotted Turtle Exhibit <i>(In honor of Mari O'Neil)</i>	\$5,000	Aquarium and display in Nature Discovery Center
Painted Turtle Exhibit <i>(In memory of Hester O'Neil)</i>	\$5,000	Aquarium and display in Nature Discovery Center
Box Turtle Exhibit <i>(In honor of Bodhi Balina)</i>	\$5,000	Housing and display in Nature Discovery Center
Corn Snake Exhibit <i>(In honor of Abby, Elias & Fiona: snake lovers always)</i>	\$5,000	Housing and display in Nature Discovery Center
Sensory Stations	\$5,000	Frog calls, scent boxes, skulls, wings, and fee for learning with all senses
